Monthly Reporting Standards for Timeliness and Completeness Assessment

Data timeliness is calculated based on the time interval between the date a case is received at the CCCR and the **date of first admission** to your facility. We are using 8 months as the definition of timely. Cases received at the CCCR within 8 months of date of first admit to your facility are considered timely. We have set a timeliness goal of 80%, i.e. 80% or more of your cases must be received by the CCCR within 8 months of admission to your facility.

For completeness calculations, only Colorado residents at diagnosis and only analytic cases (class of case 0-2) are included. We will count the number of cases reported in the first 18 months of the previous two years and use this number to calculate an average annual case count. The number of cases reported in the current year(s) of interest will be compared to the average annual case count. For example, if we are reporting on 2004 admitted cases, we will take the number of cases admitted to your facility January 2002 – June 2003, and divide that number by 1.5 (to annualize it). This is your comparison or “benchmark” caseload number. Then we count the number of cases first seen in 2004 that you have reported to date and divide that number by your comparison number to obtain your completeness percentage.

The table below shows month by month which cases you should be abstracting and the completeness standard for that month. You are expected to be 100% complete for the reporting year by August of the current year.

ICD-9-CM CODES FOR CASEFINDING

Description:

International Classification of Diseases, Ninth Revision

Rationale:

Casefinding is done using ICD-9-CM 2007 diagnostic codes to identify reportable neoplasms. A reportable neoplasm is described as any neoplasm with a fifth digit morphology code of '2' (in situ) or '3' (invasive). Some cases are also collected that are benign '0' and borderline '1' tumors.

Reporting Nonanalytic Cases

Description:

It is required that any patient, who is a resident of Colorado at the time of their initial diagnosis, with a reportable tumor or neoplasm is reported to the Central Cancer Registry (CCCR) for incidence surveillance.

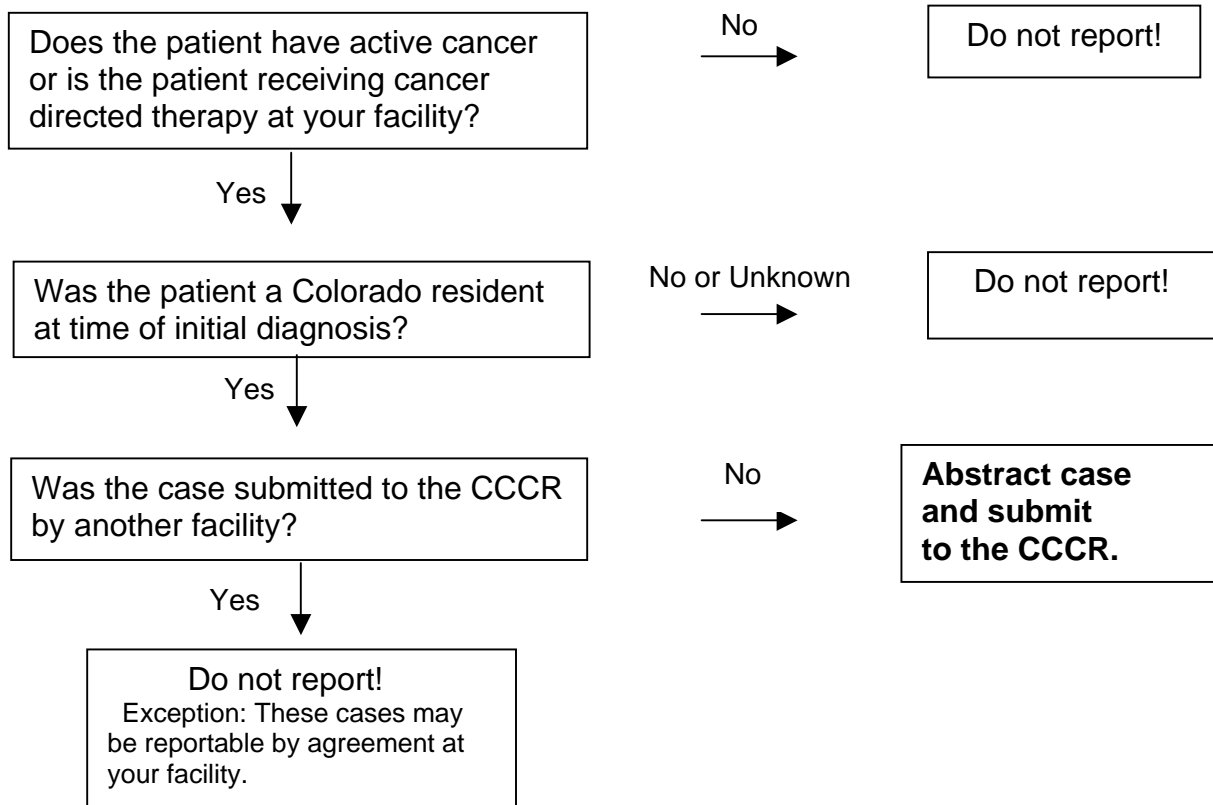
Rationale:

In order to insure all reportable tumors are submitted to the state, the CCCR requires hospital registries to submit data on nonanalytic cases if the address at the time of diagnosis is known to be in Colorado and the case has not been reported by any other hospital.

Instructions: If the case is nonanalytic for your hospital, yet the patient has active cancer or is receiving treatment for cancer at your hospital, first determine if the patient was a Colorado resident at initial diagnosis. Next, call the CCCR to determine if the case has been reported by another hospital. If the case has not been reported you need to abstract the case. If the case has been reported, we may still ask you for information regarding their diagnosis to update or complete our records.

NOTE: Although this policy addresses the state requirements, keep in mind that physicians at your facility may want to include nonanalytic cases in their cancer case counts.

NON-REPORTABLE CASE LIST

Description:

A record of the cases you do not report.

Rationale:

A non-report list kept by the hospital registry to identify cases reviewed in the casefinding process that are non-reportable. This list can be useful for your own casefinding activities as well as for the routine re-casefinding audits performed by the Colorado Central Cancer Registry. Referring to the list can eliminate unnecessary pulling of charts.

Instructions:

At a minimum, this list should include the patient's name, date they were seen, diagnosis (site and perhaps histology) and the reason they were not reported. You may find additional information such as birth date helpful as well. Examples of legitimate reasons for non-reports:

- Hx of cancer; NED at this visit
- Non-diagnostic terminology is used and case is not reportable
